

## Robin Harris, Scripps Ranch Swim & Racquet Club Racquet Sports Director

Robin Harris is a former professional tennis player and longtime tennis coach at SRSRC. Raised in the La Jolla area, she became one of the notable Southern California players of her era.

Harris competed on the professional tour during the 1970s and appeared in the main draws of several major tournaments, including the **French Open, Wimbledon**, and the **US Open**. Her best Grand Slam results included reaching the second round at Wimbledon in 1978 and the US Open in 1977.

Before her professional career, Harris made history at San Diego City College as the **first woman to play on the school's men's junior college tennis team**, helping the team win a state title.

After her touring career, she remained deeply involved in tennis as a coach and mentor in Southern California. Over several decades she has worked as a tennis professional and racquet sports director, helping develop players of all ages and levels. Her accomplishments also include success in senior and international tennis events, including an **International Tennis Federation (ITF) World Mixed Doubles title** and multiple national senior titles.

In recognition of her contributions to the sport, Harris was inducted into the **Southern California Tennis Association Senior Hall of Fame**.

Today, Robin Harris continues to be active in the San Diego tennis community as a coach, instructor, and ambassador for the game.
